



Safety and hygiene measures





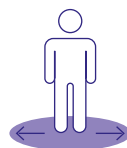
We always want to have a fun tournament. But this year fun goes together with common sense, safety and self and mutual protection.

General guidelines

All measures below are compulsory for all participants. They are based on the rules set and supported by the Spanish Tennis Federation, the Spanish Ministry of Sports and Ciudad de la Raqueta. Players must read, understand and accept all of them in order to take part in the Tournament.

Two meters physical distance, face mask and constant washing are our best allies. All players will be provided with one washable facemask and one 100ml hand sanitizer bottle. Hydrogel will also be available at the players desk and in several points at both Ciudad de la Raqueta venue.

- Please follow all directions given by the tournament crew/officials at all times
- Corporal temperature will be measured everyday upon players arrival, prior to their first match
- Please, wash your hands before and after your matches
- No hugs, no kisses, no high fives, no handshakes





Hygiene

- Wash your hands frequently
- Must not share objects
- Use face mask until you are inside the tennis court
- Cover your face if you need to sneeze/cough
- Use tissues and dispose of them responsibly after use
- Use your own bottle of water and don't share it
- Try not to touch your face during training/game



Sports equipment

- New balls will be provided for every match
- Disinfect your court equipment before and after usage
- Disinfectant will be provided on all courts
- Don't spit on the court, use tissues



Safety

- Keep 2 meters interpersonal distance at all times
- Avoid cash, card always preferred
- Use opposite sides on court after the break
- Avoid handshake or kissing after every match
- Arrive at the venue with your tennis outfit on

- Hand sanitizer available throughout the facilities
- Constant cleaning of the common areas
- Daily disinfection performed by Ocean Group
